

Teacher-Made Story Reminders

Materials needed:

Gather these supplemental items ahead of time to make your weekly preparation easier: white construction paper (9" x 12"); 4 1/2" x 6" white construction paper; paper scraps of assorted colors; paper towels; black crayon; brass paper-fasteners (brads); razor blade; string, yarn, or ribbon.

Lesson 1 Praying in God's house
(1 Samuel 1:1-20)

Materials needed: kneeling Hannah and yellow base strip from sheets 3, 6; tape or glue.

Fold the strip lengthwise on long dotted line. Then fold doubled strip on short dotted line, as shown in photo.

Fold Hannah on the dotted line at the top of her head. Paste praying picture inside one fold of strip marked, "Pray unto God" from page 6. Glue picture of her holding baby Samuel inside other fold marked, "He will hear us."

Lesson 2 Going to God's house
(1 Samuel 1:24-28; 2:1, 26)

Materials needed: figure of Hannah and child Samuel and "feet" wheel from sheet 3; brass paper-fastener (brad).

For greater durability, mount wheel and figures on tag-board and cut them out. Fasten wheel in place behind figure with a brass paper-fastener (brad).

Lesson 3 Helping in God's house
(1 Samuel 2:11, 18-21; 3:15)

Materials needed: one 9" x 12" sheet of construction paper lettered as shown in sketch; black crayon; words from sheet 6; razor blade.

Give a sheet to each child. Use a black crayon to outline the child's hand as in sketch below. With a razor blade, make slits on either side of hand. Insert paper towel in slit. See 2s & 3s Teaching Guide for guided conversation.
