



Salvation in Christ

LESSON: Romans 10:5-17

GOLDEN TEXT—"If thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved" (Romans 10:9).

OUR LESSON TALK

No one is good enough to get to heaven. We are born with a sin nature and cannot keep the law perfectly. If God had not reached out to save us, we would have no hope.

The Lord Jesus Christ did all the work for our salvation. If we truly believe that Jesus died in our place and rose again, God says that we are saved. He makes us righteous.

After we hear God's Word and believe it, God expects us to confess Jesus before people. That means to tell people what Jesus has done for us. We should not be ashamed of Jesus or embarrassed to talk about Him.

Many people still have not heard the good news of salvation. God wants us to take the gospel to the world. We cannot go to many nations ourselves, but we ought to help other people go in our place. That is what Christian missionaries do: they represent us when they go to tell others about Jesus.
