Fall 2005 <i>Obedience;</i> <i>God's Care;</i> <i>Thanksgiving</i> (Packet #1101)	Obedience (Noah builds the ark); God's Care (Noah and his family); Thanksgiving (stories about Jesus)	Genesis; Deuteronomy; Psalms; Matthew; Mark; John; 2 Corinthians; Hebrews; 1, 2 Peter	Know Noah obeyed God, God cared for Noah, Jesus is our best friend; begin to obey without fussing; realize God is good; recognize things for which to thank God.
Winter 2005–06 <i>Jesus Is Born;</i> <i>Jesus Grows Up</i> (Packet #1102)	Jesus Is Born; Jesus Grows Up (wise men, in the temple at age 12, healing miracles)	Psalms; Jeremiah; Matthew; Mark; Luke; John; 1 John	Know Jesus is God's Son, Mary and Joseph cared for baby Jesus, Jesus grew, grown-up Jesus did miracles; associate Jesus with Christmas; realize Jesus grew.
Spring 2006 <i>Friends;</i> <i>Loving;</i> <i>Caring</i> (Packet #1103)	Friends (Jesus' friends); Loving (Easter); Caring (stories about Moses)	Exodus; Matthew; Mark; Luke; John; Acts; Ephesians; Hebrews; 1 Peter; 1 John	Know that Jesus had friends, helped people, died but lives again; know that Moses' family cared for him, Moses led God's people; begin to show kindness to others and share; thank God for His care.
Summer 2006 <i>God's World</i> (Packet #1104)	God's World Begins (creation); Wonderful Things in God's World (creation and seasons); People in God's World (Adam and Eve, the first family)	Genesis; Job; Psalms; Song of Solomon; John	Know that God made all things, planned for seasons, planned for families; begin to appreciate the world God made; realize God made him; thank God for his family.
Fall 2006 <i>God's House</i> (Packet #1105)	Building God's House (David; Solomon); Learning in God's House (various characters); Helping in God's House (Samuel)	Joshua; 1, 2 Samuel; 1, 2 Kings; 1, 2 Chronicles; Psalms	Know Bible-time people went to God's house and helped there; realize that church is a special place; participate in singing, giving, praying, and learning God's Word; begin to help in his church room.
Winter 2006–07 <i>God Sends His Son;</i> <i>David Pleases God</i> (Packet #1106)	God Sends His Son (birth of Jesus); David Pleases God (from shepherd boy to king)	1, 2 Samuel; Psalms; Proverbs; Luke; Galatians; Colossians; 1 John	Know God loved us and sent His Son; know Christmas is Jesus' birthday; realize some ways that he can please God as David did; develop the ability to be helpful and obedient.
Spring 2007 <i>Jesus' Love and Care;</i> <i>Peter Loves Jesus</i> (Packet #1107)	Jesus' Love and Care (Jesus teaches and heals; Easter); Peter Loves Jesus (Peter in the book of Acts)	Joshua; Psalms; Matthew; Mark; Luke; John; Acts; Hebrews; 1 John	Know Jesus loved and cared for people; know that he can talk to God in prayer at any time; recognize ways Jesus loves and cares for him; praise God that Jesus is living; thank God for strong legs and for mothers.
Summer 2007 <i>God's Loving Care;</i> <i>God's Gifts</i> (Packet #1108)	God's Loving Care (God cares for Paul, Elisha, Naaman); God's Gifts (how God provided for the Israelites and for us)	Exodus; Deuteronomy; 2 Kings; Nehemiah; Psalms; Acts; Philippians; 2 Timothy; 1, 2 Peter	Know God cared for Bible people; know God provided water, food, and clothes for His people; realize God cares for him and meets his needs; thank God for His care.
