<b>Fall 2004</b> <i>Our Great God</i>  (Packet #1309)	In the Beginning (Creation and Fall); Abraham; Jacob	Genesis; Exodus; Deuteronomy; Psalms; Isaiah; Ezekiel; Matthew; Romans; Colossians; 2 Timothy; Hebrews; James; 2 Peter	Learn about how the Bible came to us, about creation, and about how sin entered the world; know highlights from the lives of Abraham and Jacob; understand God's provision for salvation; develop trust in God.
<b>Winter 2004–05</b> <i>We Learn to Worship God</i>  (Packet #1310)	God's Great Promise (Jesus' birth); Prayer; Worship	Genesis; 1 Samuel; 1, 2 Kings; 1, 2 Chronicles; Isaiah; Matthew; Luke; John; Acts	Understand that God promised Isaiah He would send His Son; thank God for sending His Son; begin to pray according to God's will; memorize Matthew 6:9–13; learn and practice ways to worship God.
<b>Spring 2005</b> <i>Our Living Lord</i>  (Packet #1311)	Jesus, Our Lord (Easter); Paul Serves the Living Lord	Genesis; Exodus; Deuteronomy; Psalms; Matthew; Mark; Luke; John; Acts; 2 Corinthians; Philippians; 1 Thessalonians; Hebrews; 1 John	Learn how to use God's Word to overcome temptation; know that Jesus gives eternal life to those who trust in Him; worship and praise Jesus as Lord; understand how missionary Paul served the Lord; desire to obey God's Word and to trust God for help.
<b>Summer 2005</b> <i>Men Who Lived for God</i> (Packet #1312)	Joseph; Joshua; Daniel	Genesis; Numbers; Deuteronomy; Joshua; Psalms; Isaiah; Daniel; Acts; Ephesians; Colossians; Hebrews; 1 John	Understand how Joseph, Joshua, and Daniel lived for God; desire to do right regardless of what others do; know that he can do difficult work as he trusts God; decide to obey and serve God.
<b>Fall 2005</b> <i>God Cares for Us and Helps Us</i> (Packet #1313)	God Cares for Us (provision of needs); God Helps Us Live for Him (various Bible characters)	Genesis; Leviticus; Deuteronomy; Joshua; Ruth; 2 Kings; Psalms; Isaiah; Jeremiah; Matthew; Luke; John; Ephesians; Philippians; Hebrews; 1 Peter; 1 John	Know how God cared for Bible people such as Ruth and Elisha; associate God's love with His provision for needs; know that receiving Christ is the only way of salvation; obey God; experience the joy of giving.
<b>Winter 2005–06</b> <i>Learning about the Lord Jesus</i> (Packet #1314)	Jesus Is the Son of God (birth and early life); People Jesus Knew; People Jesus Helped (miracles)	Joshua; Psalms; Isaiah; Matthew; Mark; Luke; John; Hebrews; 1 John	Learn about the birth of John the Baptist; understand that Jesus is God's Son, the promised Savior; praise God for sending His Son; grow in understanding of Biblical salvation; respond to the Spirit's conviction; depend on Jesus' power to solve problems.
<b>Spring 2006</b> <i>Our Loving Savior</i>  (Packet #1315)	Jesus Shows His Power (over demons and death); Jesus Shows His Love (events leading up to and including Easter); Believing on the Lord Jesus	Psalms; Isaiah; Matthew; Mark; Luke; John; Acts; Romans; Philippians; 1 Timothy; Hebrews; 1 Peter	Know that Jesus gives eternal life to those who trust in Him; learn about the final events of Jesus' life on earth; want to respond in faith to Him; love and praise Jesus for all He has done for us; show concern for others.
<b>Summer 2006</b> <i>We Learn to Please God</i>  (Packet #1316)	Obedying Pleases God; Trusting Pleases God; Being Kind Pleases God (all Old Testament characters)	Genesis; Exodus; Deuteronomy; Joshua; Judges; 1, 2 Samuel; Nehemiah; Esther; Psalms; Isaiah; Jeremiah; Daniel; Jonah; Luke; John; Acts; 1 Corinthians; Ephesians; Philippians	Learn about Old Testament characters who pleased God; know God's ways are best; obey God even in hard things; know that he can trust God to do what He has promised; desire to please God by being kind to others.
<b>Fall 2006</b> <i>Stories about David</i>  (Packet #1317)	David Serves God (his boyhood); God Protects David; David, the King	1, 2 Samuel; 1 Kings; 1 Chronicles; Psalms	Get an overview of David's life; know that God had a plan for David and has one for him; learn of God's care and protection; realize that obedience brings blessing, that disobedience causes grief; memorize Psalm 23.
<b>Winter 2006–07</b> <i>We Learn about Faith</i>  (Packet #1318)	The God of Our Faith (attributes of God); God Sends His Son (Jesus' birth); Faith in God's Son (New Testament characters)	Genesis; Deuteronomy; 1 Kings; Psalms; Isaiah; Matthew; Mark; Luke; John; Romans; Ephesians; Colossians; Hebrews; 1 John	Know how Bible characters evidenced faith in God; know that faith is to believe what God says; understand that God is holy and faithful; respond in faith to God, Who keeps His promises; desire to evidence faith and spiritual growth.
<b>Spring 2007</b> <i>God's Word Teaches Us</i>  (Packet #1319)	God's Word Teaches Us about the Church (answers to basic questions); about Jesus (includes Easter); about Living for Him (stories from Acts)	Exodus; Psalms; Isaiah; Matthew—Acts; 1, 2 Corinthians; Galatians; Ephesians; 1 Thessalonians; Philemon; 1 Peter; Revelation	Understand what the church is and the meaning of baptism and communion; know that Jesus is the Son of God and the living Savior; desire to obey Jesus; develop a Biblical concept of how to live for God.
<b>Summer 2007</b> <i>Adventures with Moses</i>  (Packet #1320)	God Prepares a Leader (Moses' early life); God Protects His People; God Provides for His People; God Forgives His People	Exodus; Deuteronomy; Joshua; Psalms; Isaiah; John; Acts; 2 Corinthians; Ephesians; Philippians; Hebrews; 1 John	Get an overview of Moses' life; consider how God is preparing him to live for Him; relate God's care and protection to his life; grow in personal trust in and obedience to God.
